



How to Become a Supplier

The process

Suppliers interested in pursuing opportunities within Canada Fluorspar Inc. are encouraged to take the following steps:

- Learn about **our business** and understand **our expectations** of suppliers.
- Complete our Supplier Registration form.

This self-registration application represents an expression of interest from the supplier to conduct business with Canada Fluorspar Inc. Once submitted, your details will be assessed for inclusion on our prospective supplier database. Should your application be successful, your details will be maintained amongst a pool of prospective suppliers or be put through full trade qualification should Canada Fluorspar Inc. wish to conclude any business with you.

Should your services be specifically required by Canada Fluorspar Inc., you will be requested to complete a further, more comprehensive profile. Although you have submitted information, you may be required to complete additional manual forms and submit back to Canada Fluorspar Inc..

Canada Fluorspar Inc. reserves the right to verify all credentials submitted therein, prior to qualifying any supplier as an approved trade vendor / service provider.

Having registered, you will receive an email notifying you of the outcome.

Please note: Registration, or indeed full trade qualification, does not guarantee you any business from Canada Fluorspar Inc., nor does it represent a contractual agreement or arrangement in any way. Potential Suppliers will be notified of specific trade opportunities via Request for Quotes (RFQ) or tender published on our tender boards.
